







### MOUSL

The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016



## The IRCS in Mosul, Tel-Afar and the camps in one day

18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> November 2016

The IRCS beside its duty in crowd management for commemoration of Arbaeen Hussein (This weekend) in the Karbala and surrounding areas providing medical services, health, first aid and restoring family link to crowds of million visitors from Iraq, regional and international nations. The IRCS teams are in still serving the IDPs and Ninawa residence in the same inspiration to alleviate their suffering in the same neutrality and humanity mandated by the fundamental principles of the Red Cross Red Crescent movement.

Daily trips inside Mousl to cover different zone and today we went to the west of Mousl to Tel-Afar to deliver our services as in the following summery

### The Erbil team reinforced by Baghdad branch

#### 18<sup>th</sup>Nov.

1. Mosul Hay al Samah delivering another 250 food baskets and will continue for another day
2. The IRCS with the BCF continue supporting new arrived families with 2000 hot meals, Khazer camp received 604 new families
3. Providing 270 Medical treatment

#### 19<sup>th</sup> Nov

1. In Mosul at Shallalat area (Wardik and Tel-AI-Laban) 250 Food basket were distributed to the families and we will go again soon
2. 1500 hot meals and ready meals to new arrivals 387 families in collaboration with BCF in Khazer
3. Open day PSP 180 Child in Hasan Shame, other PSP 225 person while First aid to 25 people
4. 280 medical treatments in Khazer

### The Salahaddin team reinforced by Baghdad branch

#### 18<sup>th</sup>Nov.

The IRCS back in to Mousl distributing the food baskets to: - Hay Al Intisar (this neighborhood host 88 displaced families beside 115 original families) each received food baskets. also in Haj Ali a deserted school host 100 displaced families beside Hay Ouagelay resident 47 families

#### 19<sup>th</sup> Nov

1. 3000 fresh bread distributed for IDP families in Tel –Sebat camp (15 families), Al-Alam county 65 families, Hay Al Sana'a 20 families, Hay Shesheen 200 families
2. After securing the roads by the Popular Movement Forces (PMF) The IRCS team went to the villages of Tel-Afar to distribute food basket ,50 families in Hweyat village t, 70 families in Sellmanny village and 170 families in Al-Gerin village.
