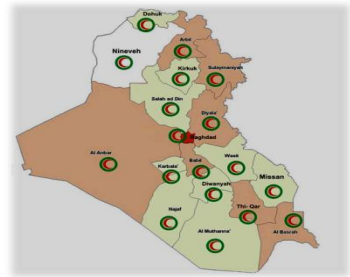
MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

Programs Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA

Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



MOSUL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism



After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The IRCS continuous response inside camps and cities

23rd -24th November 2016

Since the beginning of the Liberation Operations, The IRCS was keen to keep supporting the vulnerable inside the camps and the cities that been affected by the operation directly or cities with vulnerable people in its hosting communities in all possible means to alleviate their suffering as summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branch team with Baghdad Branch support

1. **In camps and cities** 3000 fresh bread daily (total 6000 fresh bread) supporting vulnerable families inside the camps (Al Hajaj 200 families and 30 families in Tel-Sebat) and inside the inside different city neighborhoods (Hay Al-Jamaeya /Sheshyn 70 families and Hay Al-Qadyssia 60 families).
2. **Tel-Sebat camp** with a total number of 27 families were supported with (162 blankets, 27 food baskets each with added 35 Kg Rice pack ,27 stove ,27 kitchen sets ,27 hygiene sets and 54 Jerri cans)

The IRCS Erbil Branch team supported by Mosul branch and IRCS/HQ

1. **Mosul /Hay Al Samah Al-Olla** visit on the 23rd November to distribute 350 food baskets and 200 blankets for the families
2. **Khazer Camp**
 - 2400 Hot meals distribution to the new arrivals 248 families for the past two days
 - 300 food baskets distributed to the new arrivals
 - 340 medical cases treated
 - First aid 50 cases while the psychosocial support through open day 130 children and tent visit 55
3. **Hasan Shame Camp**
 - 114 new families received in the past 2 days and they had 440 ready meals
 - 150 food baskets distributed to the new arrivals
 - 256 medical case treated at the night shift clinic
 - First aid 160 cases, while the psychosocial support open day 160 children and tent visit 35
