The IRCS dissemination team always embrace the opportunities to aware the people about the international humanitarian laws and anti-violence culture

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrah Checkpoint

1. 13,300 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 400 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 12,300 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 400 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 108,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,800 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Al Salamyia, Jada'a, Shahama, Hamam Al-Alil and the checkpoints
2. 205 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside 5 cases were transferred to Qayara hospital
3. Al Salamyia camp received 400 ready meal packs

##### EAS

IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC 12 cases 4 medical cases from Badosh clinic and 8 cases from Al-Refae clinic to different hospitals operating as following:-

- To PMS hospital 8 cases and one case to Butler hospital
- To Aspen hospital 2 cases and one case to Taylor hospital

**Inside Mosul** 696 Families in Hay Al-Mesheryafa received relief, pack (each pack of one food basket and 2 water bottle dozen sets) with the IFRC

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 858 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. 1,153 medical cases treated: 880 case with Qatar RC and 273 cases at Hasan Shame night shift
4. 400 families in Jama Kur received food baskets with IFRC
5. 400 families in Hasan Shame received relief pack each pack contain food basket, kitchen set, hygiene kit, tarpaulin, 4 blankets and mattresses) with the IFRC
6. 200 families in Alton Kupree received food basket with the Turkish RC

**Inside Mosul** Trucking of 1,260 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC

#### The IRCS Duhok Branch

1. **Cash donation** 542 families received cash donation with the German RC in the camps as following

2. the IRCS health team had psychosocial support to 22 women and 15 men through 15 tents visits in Domiz 2 camp
3. The IRCS dissemination team had the following activities
  - Local radio broadcast in Arabic language about the International Humanitarian Laws
  - Domiz camp lecture about the IHL and Ramadan night ceremony for the camp residence
