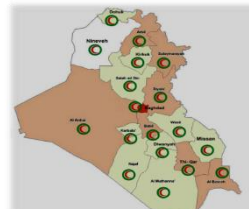




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The IRCS Health Teams

23rd -24th September 2017

The IRCS health teams supported the families with different health and medical services inside city, camps especially checkpoints.

Total 556 families displaced from liberation operation; Haweja'a 434 and from West Anbar operation 122 in past 48 hours

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

Kilo 18 Checkpoint and camp

1. Distribution 122 ready meal packs sets to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Distribution of 100 ice blocks to people
3. Psychosocial support to 67 person
4. 3 First aid workshop to 42 men
5. Psychosocial support to 116 children , 12 tents visits and 40 men
6. Health promotion and personal hygiene to 109 person

The IRCS Salahaddin Mousl, Wasit, Al-Muthana and Baghdad Branches

Haj Ali Checkpoint

434 families displaced from Es-Sdera, Al-Zabb and Shayalla (Shirqat) received ready meal packs

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 108,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,800 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 400 families in Madraj camp received relief pack (Kitchen set , hygiene set ,stove ,kettle ,thermos ,tarpaulin ,2 towels ,2 Jerri cans and 6 blankets)with the ICRC.
3. 304 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU , 12 cases admitted and 75 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
4. Health team in Madraj and Jada'a camp delivered Health promotion and personal hygiene 139 children , 72 young men and 27 women

EAS Transporting one case from IRCS/PHC in Madraj to MSF hospital with Norwegian RC

Inside Mousl

1. IRCS/ PHC 583 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Distribution of 2850 food baskets to families in Hay Al-Araby
3. Psychosocial support in Wade Hajar and Hay Nablus for 487 children, 7 house visits with 178 adults

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution 60,000 bread inside camps

Inside Mousl

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 200 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
