

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman, Beirut and Tehran



MOSUL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings, almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively; yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016



The IRCS records exceed quarter million bread distributed in 2 camps

2nd December 2016

Since 18th October the IRCS Erbil branch start distribution 5000-7000 fresh bread daily to the IDPs in camp of Khazer and Hasan Shame after less than a month each camp has its own bakery added to the service (6 bakeries in Erbil and one in Salahaddin [producing daily 15000 fresh bread). The IRCS set a new record of 270 000 bread distributed by the two branches to the IDP in camps and vulnerable families inside cities. The latest IRCS response activities are summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branch with support of Muthana and Basra branch

The IRCS was the 1st responder to families received in **Tel Sebat camp** and **Al-Hajaj camp** with water bottles, ready meals and bread. Those 121 families were allocated from Jada'a camp to Tel-Sebat 71 families while Al Hajaj received 50 families.

The **Jada'a camp** had the health teams visit to provide the following services: -

1. First aid to 27 people also providing 2 first aid kits, while medication distributed to 57 person
2. Psychosocial support open day to 190 children with adult support the beneficiaries were 59 males and 44 female

The IRCS Erbil branch with support of Diala Branch

Khazer Camp

1. Distribution of 1000 hot meals and bread
2. 210 medical cases treated
3. Open day Psychosocial support to 270 children beside educating them against war remnants
4. Adult Psychosocial support 56
5. Health promotion and preventing cholera 72 people
6. First aid training lectures 30 person

Hasan Shame Camps

1. Received 182 new families in Hasan Shame 3
2. 91 medical cases treated at the night shift
3. 4 tents were damaged and replaced for new tents because of the rains .
