**Programs** Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA

Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



**MOUSL** The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016

Nekezliea camp start to receive IDPs our Duhook branch installed their office and ware house there beside 3 tents added to the screening zone

#### **The IRCS Duhook branch**

Nekezliea camp start receiving 90 individuals at the screening zone they received their ready meals and water bottle beside assess their needs

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin, Basra and Muthana branches**

- 3000 fresh bread were distributed to the vulnerable families in Tikrit district Al-Qadyssia 100families, inside Tel-Sebat camp 100 families while in Al-Hajaj 100 families.
- Visit Al-Shoorra County to assess the returnee and the infrastructure of the city and surrounding villages. The returnee whom suffering from damage houses, absent winterization items, no food ration and absence of the medical services in extensive range. the total number of families was 2514 families divided into ,1361 families in Al Shoorra City while 1153 families residing in the following villages (Al-Mamjan, Al Shoorra Al-Jadeda, Tel -AlMahar, Surooj, Zalhaf, Al-Shoorra Al-Thanya, Zahra Khatoon, Abo Feshkka, Al-Shaq and Tel-Waye).
- The health teams visit Jada'a camp to deliver different psychosocial support programs to benefit 207 males and 186 females, , First aid and medication distributed to 141 beneficiaries and distribution of eleven First aid bags

#### **The IRCS Erbil and diala branches**

Khazer camp

- 1200 hot meal delivered to the families
- 265 medical Rx


Hasan shame camps

- 105 medical cases treated at the night shift
- 183 newly arrived families received ready meals
- 300 families received baby milk and diapers, hygiene set, kitchen sets, stoves and tarpaulins

The health team activities in those camps beside the Psychosocial support and ERWA to 250 adults, open day to 123 children, health promotion 67 first aid to 45 person including transferee lady in labor with our ambulance to the hospital and suffocated child
