

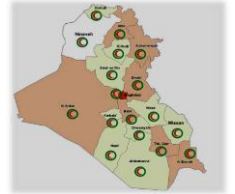


## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



**MOUSL** The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism  
After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016



## The IRCS greetings for Moulid Nabawi Mubarak and Human Right Day

The IRCS send greeting to the world for the Moulid Nabawi Mubarak and celebrates the Human right Day beside our week celebrating the volunteer's day

To summarize today activities as following

### **The IRCS Baghdad branch**

the health and first aid stations annually are stationed next to Imam A'adham shrine in Al-Adhamyia city to ensure safety and wellbeing of the celebrating crowds, this year more than 40 volunteers participated from early morning hours to cover 24 hours' celebrations

### **The IRCS Salahaddin and Babel Branches**

1. Celebration the world volunteer's day
2. 3000 fresh bread distributes in Tel-Sebat camp 300 families
3. Jada'a camp distribution of 500 relief set to 500 families each relief set content (food basket ,35 Kg rice, kitchen set, hygiene set, stove ,2 Jerri cans ,2 towels ,6 blankets and one kettle)

### **The IRCS Erbil, Mosul, Baghdad and Diala Branches**

1. Celebration of the world volunteer's day
2. 15000 fresh bread distributed inside the camps of Khazer and Hasan shame
3. 1500 hot meals distributed to the new families
4. 288 medical cases treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 173 medical cases treated at night shift in Hasan Shame
6. 225 relief sets distributed in Hasan shame 3 (relief set contain food basket, hygiene set. kitchen set, blankets and water bottle set) with the ICRC and German red cross
7. 217 new arrived families to Hasan shame received ready meals and water bottle sets
8. Distribution of 80 cloth boxes with blankets and children toys with the Turkish red crescent
9. Health teams in camps Psychosocial Support adult 350 families' different approaches while Open day for 650 Children, health promotion and personal hygiene to 500 children while awareness against war remnant to 180 beneficiaries

Distribution of 145 food baskets in villages of Sada and Ba'aweza in Mousl suburbs
