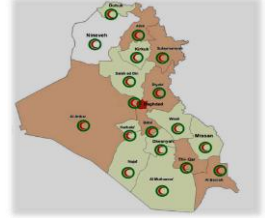




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The IRCS continue to serve IDPs inside the camps

29th -30st December 2016

The year 2016 is almost ending with continuous influx of IDPs toward Hasan Shame camps day and night despite the below zero temperature and shortage of fuel.

Many families reside in Salahaddin inside deserted building, under construction and government building. The IRCS team had surveyed these families and are provided with relief items.

The days' activities are summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branches

12000 fresh bread distributed to the IDPs families in camps and inside city of Tikrit as following :-

- 600 families in Tel-Sebat camp
- 220 families at Al Hajaj camp
- 30 families at Dream city building
- 85 families Qadysea 500 district
- 72 families at Aboaqrab building
- 25 families in building next to private secondary school
- 48 families next to Tikrit main street
- 45 families in under construction building next to Abdurraheem mosque
- 65 families inside various houses in Hay Al Qadysea
- 10 families in hay Al Shuhada'a government building

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul Branches

1. 269 new families arrived to Hasan Shame
2. 60,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 2950 hot meals with the BCF
4. 608 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 202 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
6. Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treat 260 medical cases
7. Distribution 50 families received food baskets in Hasan Shame U2
8. 182 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contain one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
9. Distribution of 340 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
10. Distribution 120,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps

The IRCS health teams delivered: -

- Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 210 children and 62 tent visits
- The health promotion and personal hygiene to 70 people of different age group.
