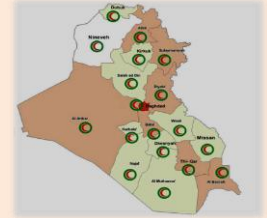




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..((49)) 6th January 2017 Friday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The IDP wave is continuous

4th -5th January 2017

The IRCs teams were first responders to 763 families newly displaced from Mosul city toward Nerkizlee1, Khazer and Hasan Shame camp (KRG borders with Mosul)

The past two days' activities are summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Missan and Dewanyia Branches

- 12000 fresh bread distributed to 1125 families in Tel-Sebat and 150 families in al Shahama
- 500 families in Jada'a 4 received relief pack (food basket, kitchen set, hygiene set, thermos, tarpaulin, kettle, 2 towels and 2 Jerri cans and one stove)
- The health team delivered medical and health services between Al-Madraj, Tel-Sebat and Jada'a camps: -
 - Medical services to 470 people
 - First aid response to 76 person
 - First aid training to 30 adults in 2 sessions
 - Distribution of 5 First aid bag
 - Psychosocial support to 250 children and 724 adult
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 680 person

The IRCS Erbil, Babel and Mosul branches aided by Baghdad/ HQ

- Within the past two days the arrival of 689 families to the camps distributed as 488 in Khazer while Hasan Shame received 201 families of them
- 60,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
- Distribution of 4000 hot meals with the BCF
- 711 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
- 210 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
- Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treat 440 medical cases with the Danish Red Cross
- 280 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contains one food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
- Distribution of 353 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame & Khazer
- Distribution 398,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
- Distribution of trash bags to 70 families

The IRCS health teams delivered Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 310 children and 25 tent visits beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 290 people of different age group.

The IRCS Duhok branch

Newly arrived 74 families to Nerkizlee 1 camps on 5th January; all the 156 families received relief pack (each pack consists of 6 blankets, kerosene stove, kitchen set) with the German Red Cross
