We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Nerkizlee 1 camp continue to receive IDPs

6th-7th January 2017

Within the past 2-3 days **585 families** arrived to camps in the three zones with the IRCS teams waiting to aid and deliver relief.

The past two days' activities summarized below -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Missan and Dewanyia Branches

During the past 2 days 185 new families arrived to Jada'a 4 camp

Inside camps 6000 fresh bread distributed to 150 families Al-Shahama, 150 Al-Hajaj and 300 Tel-Sebat

Jada'a4 camp

- First aid delivered to 115 first aid also six lectures to 45 individuals
- Psychosocial support to 110 adult teenage 70 and 75 children
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 220 people

Al-Madraj camp

- Distribution of 200 ready meal
- Health team provided first aid to 132 people, first aid lectures to 158 people
- Psychosocial support service to 463 adult and 280 children
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 300 beneficiaries

Inside city of Tikrit host 1000 families in different locations including government buildings like the postal office our health team this time provided first aid to 53 people first aid 3 lectures to 42 beneficiaries and Distribution of 10 first aid bags

- 150 person received different medications
- Psychosocial support delivered to 59 adults and 335 children
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 224 people

The IRCS Erbil, Muthana and Mosul Branches

1. 254 new families arrived to Hasan Shame
2. 90,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 3500 hot meals with the BCF
4. 940 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 197 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
6. 254 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contain one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,stove,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
7. Distribution of 254 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
8. Distribution 750,000liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
9. Distribution trash bags and soup blocks to 130 families

The IRCS health teams delivered psychosocial support program including- the open day to 290 children and 385 adults beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 235 people of different age group. First aid 3 lectures to 54 beneficiaries and 2 people benefit from first aid services

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Arrival of 146 families to Narkezlie1 1 camp where our teams provided each family with 6 blanket, stove and kitchen set with German Red Cross
