We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The health education is as vital as relief

8th -9th January 2017

Health promotion and personal hygiene education and awareness program can reduce the morbidity among the IDP families living in insecure health environment and reduce the spread of the communicable diseases among them. The IRCS health teams have been campaigning since early days of the Mosul liberation operation inside the camp and in the hosting communities were the people of Mosul displaced. For the past two days 682 people educated in health promotion, personal hygiene and avoiding communicable diseases.

The past two days' activities is summarized below -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Missan and Dewanyia Branches

1. Distribution 12000 fresh bread to 600 IDP families inside city of Tikrit different locations and 600 families in Tel-Sebat camp
2. Distribution of 850 relief pack to families inside three camps ; 150 families in Al-Shahama camp ,260 families in Jada'a 4 and 440 families inside Al-Madraj camp (each pack consist of food basket ,thermos ,kitchen set .tarpaulin , kettle ,2 Jerri cans , 2 towels and stove)
3. Restoring the Family link 2cases in Al- Madraj camp
4. The health team were active in the following camps :-
 - Jada'a4 delivering first aid to 25 people and distribution of 15 first aid bags
 - Al-Madraj
 1. The first aid service to 122 people, 7first aid lectures to 62-person
 2. Distribution of 15 first aid bag beside the medications to 80 people
 3. The psychosocial support to320 children, 10 teenagers and 325 adults.
 4. The health promotion and personal hygiene to total 330 people.
 - Al-Shahama
 1. distribution of 200 medications ,first aid services to 25 person ,first aid lecture to 20 people
 2. distribution of 20 first aid bags
 3. the Psychosocial support to 35 children and 28 adults
 4. The health promotion to 182 beneficiaries
 - Tikrit city IDP
 1. Received 180 medications first aid services to 10 person and 2 lectures in first aid to 15 beneficiaries
 2. The psychosocial support to 40 children and 25 adults
 3. The health promotion and personal hygiene to 170 beneficiaries.

Nerkizlee camp is hosting 761 families including the newly arrived 147 families whom received from the IRCS team 6 blankets, one stove, one kitchen set and one dozen water bottle sets to each family
