

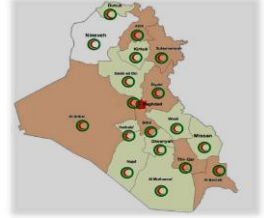

MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(53) 15th January 2017 Sunday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Back inside Mosul

12th-14th January 2017

With improve security in the liberated areas inside Mosul city; our teams went back providing aids inside two neighborhoods. The past days' activities summarized below -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branches

12,000 fresh bread distributed to families inside the camps and the city of Tikrit as following

Inside the camps, total 900 families were supported:-

- 200 of them inside Al-Hajaj camps
- 150 family in Al-Shahama camp
- 300 families in Tel-Sebat camp

Inside the city of Tikrit 550 IDP families were supported as-

- 250 families and students at the dormant of Tikrit university -
- 75 families near Al-Ehtefalat Street
- 82 families at Al-Deyom under construction buildings
- 65 families at the old building of city council
- 78 families in deserted hotels near the government Tax Assessment building

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul Branches

Inside the camps

1. Newly arrived families is 357 that were distributed as 202 to Hasan Shame and 135 families to Khazer
2. 229 returnee families from Khazer to Mosul at Kokjaleel
3. 120,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
4. Distribution of 4000 hot meals with the BCF
5. 1335 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
6. 468 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
7. 320 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contain one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
8. Distribution of 320 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
9. Distribution 940,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps

The IRCS health teams delivered Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 317 children and 40 tent visits and total adult beneficiaries 690 beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 260 people of different age group. Lecture for first aid to five adult
