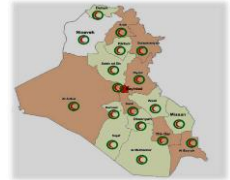




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



No More Tents!!

7th -9th March 2017

The families displaced to the south of Mosul facing absolute loaded camps and no more vacant tents the IRCS teams in Hamam Al-Alil zone offered our vehicles for sleeping of 100 families arrived on the dawn of March 8th!

The past 3-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS branches of Salahaddin, Mosul and Muthana

These branches operate in Hamam Al-Alil, Qayara Strip Camps Al-Alam camps and Tikrit camps where most of the IDPs families from the East Bank of Mosul fleeing to

1. Two equipped ambulance vehicle stationed at the Aqrab check point (Ayin Al-Gahish screening area) to help in transfer medical and surgical emergencies to neighboring hospitals we were able to transfer 25 cases including one woman in labor
2. Producing and distributing 18000 fresh piece of bread to camps of Tel-Sebat and Shahama
3. 2500 hot meals delivered immediately to the families in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 1000 Relief Pack distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp each pack contain (food basket, hygiene set and kitchen set).

The health teams operating in these zones beside the general assembly teams from Karbala delivered the following:-

- First aid to 2 people, four first aid lectures to 61 person
- 650 person with prescription received Medications
- Health promotion and personal hygiene education to 135 person
- All categories of Psychosocial program support to 170 children and 565 adults

The IRCS Erbil Branch

This team operate in Khazer and Hasan Shame camps including Jama Kur

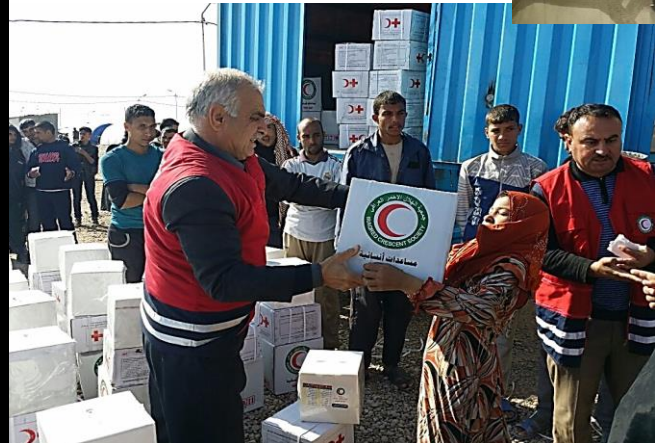
1. New located families to these camp were 375 distributed 44 families to Hasan Shame and the rest to Jama Kur
2. 180.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 5000 hot meals with the BCF
4. 627 Ready meals pack delivered to the families
5. 1225-relief pack distributed to the new families in both Hasan Shame and Jama Kur camp. Each relief pack contain (one food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets, stove, thermos, tarpaulin and 2 towel) ICRC items
5. Distribution 1,110,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
6. Total of 1758 Medical cases treated, 1100 Qatar RC, 437 at Hasan Shame night shift and 211 cases at family clinic with Danish RC
7. The IRCS health teams delivered
 - 4 first aid lectures to 112 people
 - Psychosocial support program to 722 children, 130 adults and 98 young men
 - The health promotion and personal hygiene to 794 people of different age group.
 - 65 Yazidis families received psychosocial support and hygiene sets
