**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932



### **The families returning to East Mosul**

17<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> March 2017

The families in the camp of south of Mosul are returning to their liberated areas (Al-Ma'amon, Al-Gerin and Al-Quwar)

The past two-day's activities as listed below

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin, Mosul, Missan, Basra, Babel and IRCS/HQ**

##### **Aqrab Checkpoint**

1. 64 person evacuated by our ambulances to the neighboring hospital
2. 8750 hot meals distributed to the families with 350 water bottle set
3. Ready meals pack total of 750 distributed

##### **The Camps**

1. Producing and distribution of 60000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside aqrab check point
2. Total 3400 hot meals with bread delivered half of it in Hamam al-Alil the other half in Madraj added to 300 water bottle set
3. 500 ready meal pack distributed in Madraj
4. Our water purification unit produces 2m<sup>3</sup>/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
5. Medical cases 148 cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
6. 1600 relief pack distributed to the families (each pack with food basket and kitchen set )in Haj Ali camp
7. Health team
  - Primary psychosocial support to 700 person
  - First aid services 313 person

**Inside Mosul** 4000 families received relief pack inside Mosul at (Al-Ma'amon , Al-Mansour , Hay Al-Jihad , Wade Hajar, Hay Al-Shuhada'a , Al-Somood And Tel Ruman ).each relief pack of food basket and water bottle set

#### **The IRCS Erbil with Karbala Branches**

1. Jama kur camp received 39 new families
2. 60.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 3000 hot meals with the BCF
4. 225 relief pack in Hasan shame of (one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets, stove ,thermos ,tarpaulin and 2towel)ICRC items
5. Distribution to the families of Jama Kur 500 cloth boxes with the Turkish RC
6. Distribution 642,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
7. Total of 996 Medical cases treated as :542 at Qatar RC , 309 at Hasan Shame night shift and 115 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
8. The IRCS health teams delivered
  - first aid lectures to 45 people
  - Psychosocial support program to 580 children.54 families and 21 young men
  - The health promotion and personal hygiene to 500 people of different age group.

**Inside Mosul:** the families of Hay Al Muthana received 500-relief pack (each pack with one food basket and 5 water bottle each of 17 liter)
