On 13th April and during the visit of Miss intercontinental 2016 to camp of Nerkizlee 2 camp, she joined the IRCS team during their activity and attended the Hilal day activity

The past two-day's activities as listed below:-

The IRCS Salahaddin. Najaf and Karbala branches and IRCS/HQ

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 28 cases where transferred by the ambulance
2. 8600 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
3. 300 ready meals pack distribution

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 54000 fresh bread distributed to 5400 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat ,Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside Aqrab check point
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 11000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 205 medical cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
5. Health team delivered
 - First aid services 25 patients
 - Different Psychosocial support to 354 person

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul Branches

1. 30.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution 272 ,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
3. Total of 309 Medical cases treated as :134 at Qatar RC and 175at Hasan Shame night shift
4. 250 families in Jama Kur received Nonfood item pack ;including hygiene set , kitchen set ,Jerri can and 4 blankets with one water bottle dozen set with German RC
5. Health team activities inside Baharka ,Khazer ,Hasan Shame and Harsham
 - Psychosocial support to 53 children and 58 tent visits
 - 6 First aid lecture to 86 person with first aid bag distribution to participants
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene with poster and flyers to 72 person

The IRCS Duhook Branch

1. 128 families in Nerkizlee 2 received nonfood item pack; including one stove and 6 blankets)and water bottle dozen set with German RC
2. The health team in Nerkizlee 2 camp open day activity to 50 children
3. **Hilal day** in the camp were the IRCS Team explain the international humanitarian laws and the Red Cross Red Crescent movement fundamental principles and the support rule of the IRCS to the vulnerable
